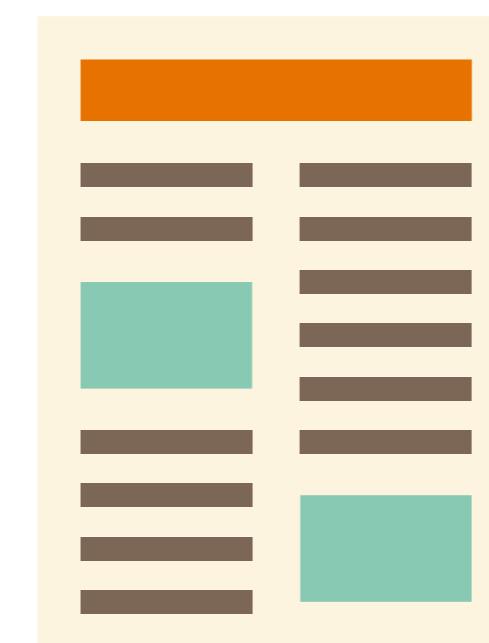
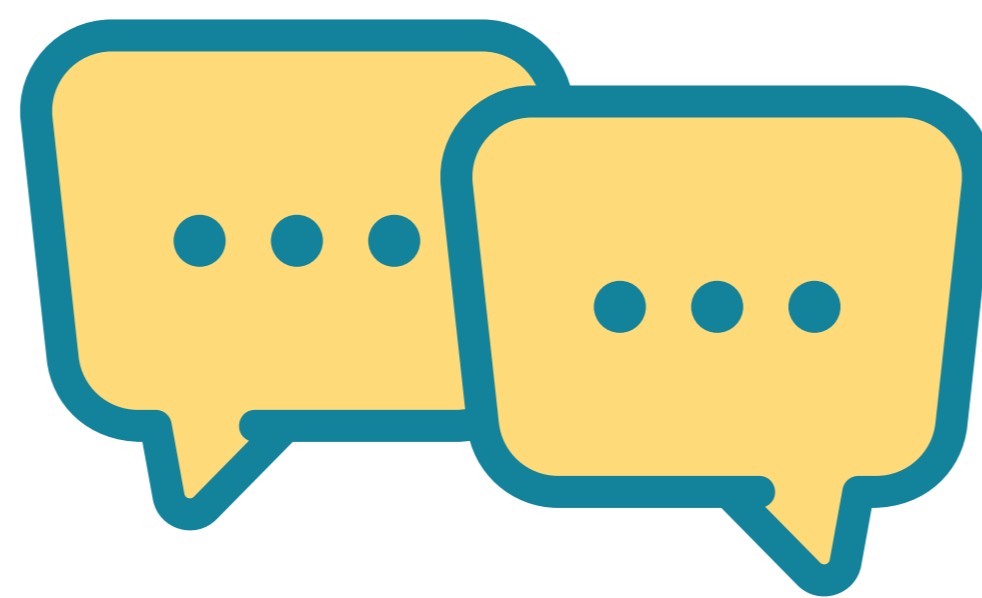

Feasibility Scale

Charity Shop

The outlet would also serve the social purpose of providing employment opportunities and valuable work experience to WSREC service users, particularly individuals from minority ethnic communities.



Friend Scheme

The concept of a friend scheme is that individuals, groups or businesses can become friends of WSREC and in doing so support the organisation financially and receive benefits and insight into WSRECs work.



Training

WSREC could design, market and sell a variety of training courses including hate crime and equality training.



Eco-Craft Workshops

Interactive workshops that provide individuals with skills such as sewing, up cycling and zero waste cooking could be sold. Workshops will give individuals the opportunity to develop skills and increase their commitment to the environment.
